The post holder is responsible for ensuring an optimum clinical learning environment for Nursing staff and the maintenance and development of professional patient care standards. The post holder will participate in the assessment, planning and evaluation patients requiring endoscopy procedures in compliance with JAG Accreditation Standards, Local Endoscopy QIP, HIQA National Standards and Quality Assurance in Endoscopy Group to overall improve patient experience, safety and quality

Responsibilities - The post holder will;

- Manage the caseload of all patients undergoing elective endoscopy (urgent, routine and surveillance) procedures within the Mercy Hospital.
- Identify and implement health promotion strategies for patient/client groups in accordance with public health agenda including diabetes/obesity/smoking cessation
- Provision of a nurse led clinic as clinically appropriate for patients who require additional support or nursing clinical intervention
- Ensure that the agreed all scheduled patients for an endoscopes have been pre-assessed
- Use the Irish Colorectal Care and Colorectal Nurses Association (ISCCNA) and other international evidence based standards and guidelines to undertake specialised nursing assessments
- Maintain and develop effective and appropriate communication and collaboration with other departments, i.e. Endoscopy department, day wards, Nursing Management, Bed Management Unit and Nurse Practice Development Unit, members of the multidisciplinary team, other agencies, colleagues, personnel, patients and their relatives/carers.
