## Fire Safety Officer (Permanent) Grade V – 37hrs per week

(Under the Governance of Mercy University Hospital Cork CLG.)

Under the general direction and control of the Technical Services Officer (TSO), the Fire Safety Officer will be responsible, in respect of such institutions and locations as may, from time to time be assigned to him / her for the following:

**Responsibilities** - The post holder will be responsible for;

- Regular inspections of buildings, means of escape and all firefighting equipment and ensuring that all equipment is properly located, well marked, in good repair and in good working order.
- Reviewing and, as necessary, drawing up of fire orders, including evacuation schemes for the various types of buildings and institutions, including schemes for evacuation of all persons with particular regard to mentally ill and non ambulant patients and to draw up fire plans of all Mercy University Hospital buildings.
- Regular and routine inspection of places, premises and equipment which present a special risk of fire and reporting any breaches of the fire prevention code.
- Instruction and training of staff in each institution in:
  - The avoidance of fire hazards;
  - The summoning of the fire brigade;
  - The operation of the fire alarm and fire equipment, and means of escape;
  - The curtailment of an outbreak of fire, pending the arrival of the fire brigade;
  - Prevention of smoke spread and evacuation of danger areas

**Eligibility Criteria - Candidates:**

- (a) (i) Hold a HETAC level 8 qualification (NQF) in engineering, fire engineering, and architecture, Health and Safety or Building Services/Building Survey.

Or

- (ii) Hold an equivalent qualification.

And

- (ii) Have four years experience in comparable Fire and Safety role.
- (b) Candidates must have the requisite technical knowledge and ability (including a high standard of suitability and managerial capacity) to discharge the functions of the post.
